

Update on Lincoln Road Projects

Quaker Street

The first phase of drainage improvements on Quaker Street is complete. This week we anticipate grinding (Bomagging) the old pavement, improving the sub-base where needed and grading the surface to restore the road crown in preparation for new paving which is planned for the first couple weeks of October. At the same time, additional drainage and culvert work will continue moving south toward River Road. The extent of continued drainage work will depend on cooperation of the weather.

East River Road

A badly deteriorated concrete box culvert near the old pallet/bobbin mill on East River Road will be rehabilitated and widened by Parent Construction of Hinesburg. Parent intends to maintain one-way traffic at all times. However there may be unanticipated delays for moving equipment and materials. One way traffic will be maintained by portable traffic signals. Construction is expected to last about three weeks. The project will include approximately 800 feet of new asphalt paving extending from the Truchon Bridge apron west to a point across from the Old Hotel Driveway .

River Road

Cracks that have appeared on east and west River Roads will be filled with a rubberized asphalt emulsion. This process intends to keep water from finding its way into the pavement **where the freeze/thaw** cycle can damage and a reduce the life expectancy of the pavement. Traffic will be slowed in the vicinity .

Drivers are reminded to slow down in construction areas and to allow a few extra minutes for getting children to and from school . Keeping everyone safe is everyone's business.
