1. The Meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Vice Chair, Mark Mulqueen
2. Ann made a motion and Sally T. seconded, to accept the minutes of our July 8, 2020 BCA meeting. Passed.
3. Announcements: Sally O. informed us that due to the Covid-19 pandemic, a ballot will be mailed to every active registered voter in Vermont for the Nov. 3, 2020 General Election. The mailing will be done under the direction of the VT Secretary of State. This should hopefully cut down on the number of people coming to the polling place on election day. Town clerks will still be responsible for receiving and counting the ballots.
4. Sally Ober made a motion to move our polling place to Burnham Hall for the Nov. 3, 2020 general election. Sally Taylor seconded. Discussion: the space in Burnham is bigger than the Town Office and will allow for better social distancing indoors. We will hopefully set up our polling place downstairs with slight changes for Covid safety protocols. Passed.
5. We reviewed our Polling Place Code of Conduct. Sally Ober made a motion to add: “During the Covid 19 pandemic, masks are required to be worn inside the polling place.” Ann seconded. Passed.
6. Adjourned at 7:27 p.m.
