Sally Ober called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. and asked for nominations for Chair of the Board of Abatement. Sally Taylor nominated Paul Forlenza. Mark seconded. There were no other nominations. Passed.

Paul took over running the meeting and gave a review of the reasons we can abate taxes.

Bill made a motion to abate the taxes for the property formerly owned by Willard Jackson, based on a manifest error. The amount to be abated is the second installment of 2020-21 taxes of \$2911.10, plus \$29.12 interest and \$232.89 penalty, for a total of \$3173.11. Sally Ober seconded. Discussion: This property was donated by Mr. Jackson to the town of Lincoln. The manifest error is that the Town can't charge or pay taxes to itself.
