1. Announcements –
 - a. It is time for Justices of the Peace to run for office. All terms end on Jan. 31, 2025. JPs are elected every two years in November. The deadline to submit nominating petitions is Monday, August 19. Connect with your party or submit petitions to Sally Ober, Town Clerk, in order to get your name on the ballot as a candidate.
 - b. No guns in the polling place. It's a new Vermont law which became effective on July 1, 2024. The Sec. of State has created posters to give notice to voters and post at the polling place.
2. Minutes from all meetings since February were approved by unanimous consent.
3. Review list of election workers: Sally T. made a motion to approve the list of election workers presented by Sally Ober. Ilana seconded. One or two more people are needed. Passed.

7. Ilana made a motion to adjourn. Sally O. seconded. Passed
