

Lincoln, VT Vote Tabulator Test Minutes

Began at 2:00 p.m.

The purpose of this event was to test the logic and accuracy of the memory cards for our vote tabulator machine, to prepare for the August 13, 2024 Vermont Primary Election. All went well except for some repeated error messages from the printer. Otherwise, the machine count matched the hand count of our test ballots. We are ready for the election.

Test ended at 3:15 p.m.

Note: I reached out to LHS via email after our test concluded. Mike Carlson helped us figure out that we had installed a roll of paper with too big of a core, which was causing the printer error messages. We found a different roll of paper with a narrower core and installed it, so hopefully this will be better on election day. If not, we found that holding the metal bar up slightly while printing, made it work.
