I have a particularized interest, as I find that my family is living under the approach and landing zone of the proposed airstrip and I have deep concerns in regards to my family's SAFETY!!

Thank you for giving me the opportunity to address this permit as I was not informed during the application process.

I would like to address today's appeal hearing by speaking on a few items.

I feel that in the past few weeks our life has been turned upside down, as we've been experiencing major, dangerous and low altitude air traffic, Making us feel that our sense of SAFETY has been greatly compromised!!

One incident we witnessed, was a plane that immediately emerged from the backwoods and performed barrel rolls, spins, summer saults, all at a very concerningly low altitude as it passed over the top of my house.

We've also witnessed a couple different incidents with what we believe to be drone's. With one of the specific incidents being quite creepy.

I can elaborate on this, if necessary..... ***

I would also like to address the most recent activity we witnessed, an extremely scary incident. We were outside on our front porch, we heard a loud noise and immediately seen a helicopter, that was coming towards our house at a very FAST speed and LOW altitude. I thought it was going to hit the chimney on our garage and then it flew directly over the middle of my house. We watched it fly to the back tree row and it appeared to either do a touchdown or a quick drop off. Within a couple of minutes, the leaves on the trees were shaking as if we were having a major wind storm, and the helicopter appeared again and came back over our house and headed West until it was out of our sight.



These are a few of the incidents that we have witnessed in the past few weeks. The matter of low altitude aircraft and aerobatics feels very UNSAFE, disturbed, and CONCERNING for my family.

I feel that what my family has been experiencing in the past few weeks, has been a "sneak peek" of what it *would* be like if the permit is granted.

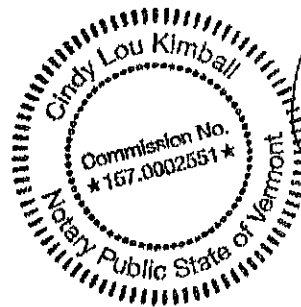

Drone elaboration

* One evening from approximately 9:15 pm until 11:45 pm we were on our front porch facing West when we started observing strange hovering objects just above the treeline. The sky was lit up well due to the moon. We noticed these objects were moving towards us, we continued to watch what appeared to be 3 different silent objects in the sky. One of the said objects appeared to approach very quickly and ahead of the others. We later noticed after this one finally reached it's destiny (to the east side of my home, out in the backwoods) that it hovered in that same spot and then a light appeared from the belly of the object. We believe this to be the "leader of the pack". We will call this Object #1. The other 2 objects approached much slower and to the east of our home. We then came inside our home and continued to watch, by now viewing this as we face the back woods of our home (East). We are now viewing the 3 said objects and object #2 which we lost view of for a while and it then comes back and takes its place in between objects #1 and #3. We stayed very focused on object #3, as it appeared to be in heavy distress. It acted like it was trying to drop down and get closer to #2. We saw it attempt to possibly Hoover down closer to a landing, but each time it attempted it would bounce back up and get higher in the sky. After several attempts and approximately 2 hrs in. Meanwhile, we now have lost vision of #1, it appears it may have landed. We then suddenly see a solid red light on a new object that we watch take off at a much faster pace and head as if it was on an emergency mission towards Burlington.
